CONDITIONAL GRANT AGREEMENT

2017/2018 GROUND SEARCH AND RESCUE PROGRAM

BETWEEN: HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN in Right of the Province of Alberta as represented by the Minister of Municipal Affairs ("the Minister")

Pincher Creek Search and Rescue Society

whose address is

("the SAR Group")

and

WHEREAS the SAR Group plans to participate in a project to enhance the delivery of ground search and rescue training throughout the province, and has applied to the Minister for a conditional grant in order to obtain financial assistance to carry out the project.

AND WHEREAS the Minister has approved the SAR Group's application and has agreed to make a conditional grant to the SAR Group pursuant to Schedule 1 of the Municipal Affairs Grants Regulation.

The parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Minister shall:
 - (a) subject to the provisions of this Agreement, pay the SAR Group a one time conditional grant of Seven Thousand Seven Hundred DOLLARS (\$7,700.00) (the "Grant") in order to carry out a project under the 2017/2018 Ground Search and Rescue Training Program, as further set out in the Grant Application, attached as Schedule "A" and forming part of this Agreement (the "Project");
 - (b) provide the Grant by lump sum payment to the SAR Group after receipt of two signed copies of the Conditional Grant Agreement;
 - (c) have the right to conduct an evaluation or audit of the Project at any time; and
 - (d) have the right to publish and distribute any report submitted by the SAR Group to the Minister on the Project.
- 2. The SAR Group shall:
 - (a) carry out the Project set out in Schedule "A" without material alteration;
 - (b) complete the Project and use the Grant by May 31, 2019;
 - (c) use the entire amount of the Grant for the purpose of carrying out the Project;
 - (d) pay any additional costs required to complete the Project if the total costs exceed the Grant;
 - (e) not use any part of the Grant to pay for training carried out or materials obtained before this Agreement came into effect;
 - (f) only use the allocated amounts for the purpose of carrying out the specific components identified in 1(a) above;
