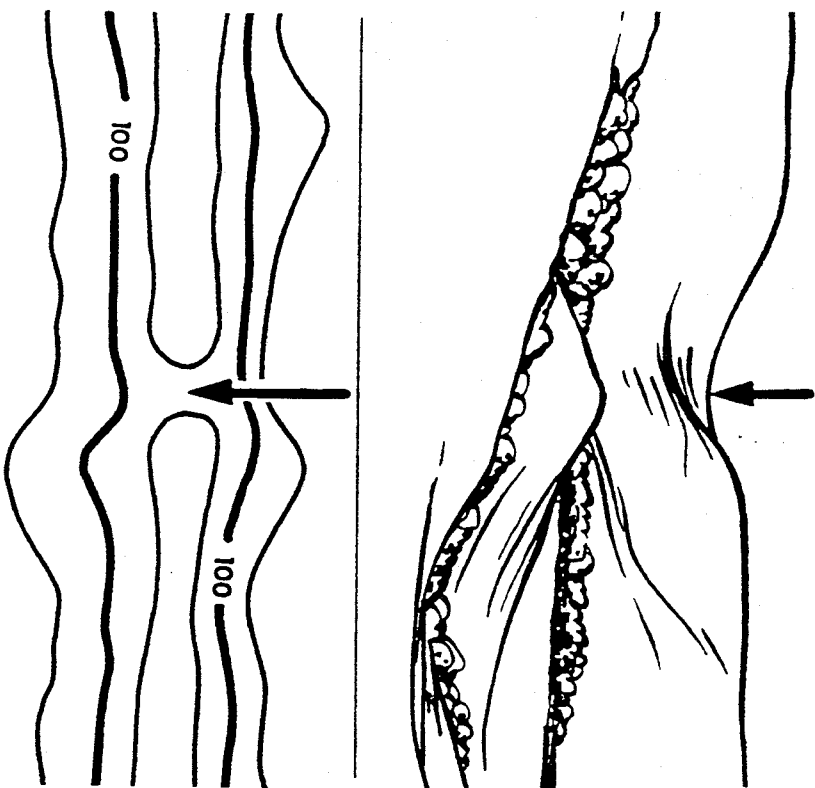
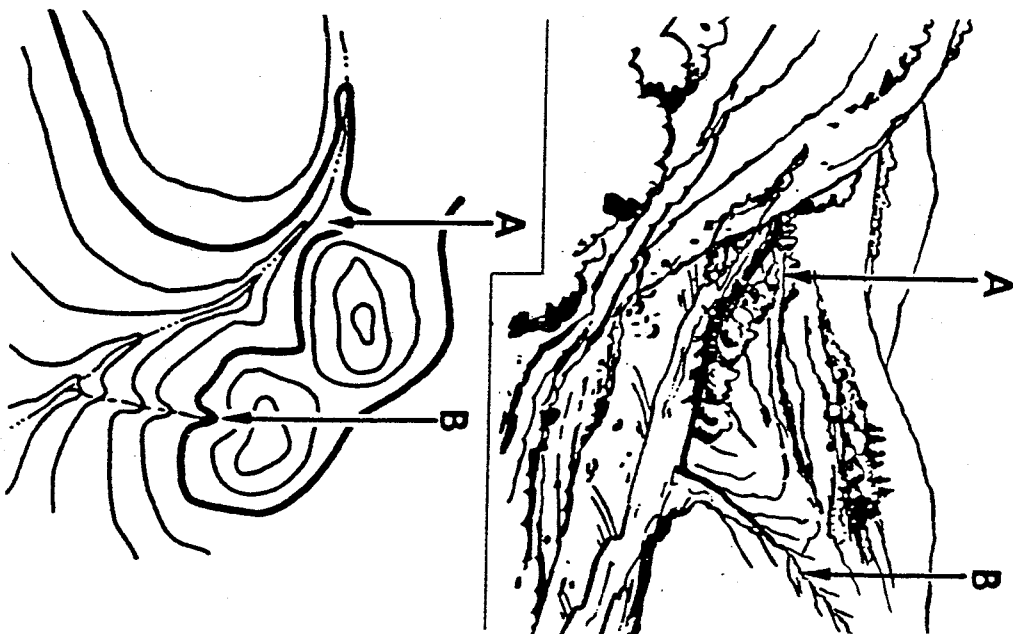


Example of how a topographical map shows topography with contour lines. "A" shows a ridgetline (line of higher elevations) and "B" shows a finger ridge or spur (smaller ridgetline).



A saddle is a lower elevation between two knolls or ridges.



"A" represents a valley with an intermittent stream. "B" represents a drainage.
